

## Seckar Wood

Seckar Wood is located just south of Wakefield off the Barnsley Road opposite Newmillerdam Country Park


Most of Seckar Wood is ancient Woodland that has changed little since the 1480's. Much of the woodland today is young birch.

Part of the Wentworth Estate, it was purchased by Warner Gothard in early 1900's a photographer with studios in Wakefield, Barnsley, Dewsbury and Leeds.

With his brothers he pioneered the montage postcard which often featured colliery, railway and local disasters.

When Warner died in 1940 the area was given to the people of Wakefield and Barnsley and is now managed by Wakefield Council.





## Seckar Pool

A small natural spring emerges from the west end of the wood and where it accumulates at the eastern end there are two small ponds collectively known as Seckar Pool.

In the 1930's Gothard decided to make use of the ponds to create an outdoor swimming pool for his family.

Construction of a summer house was started just before the outbreak of war in 1939 but got interrupted when Gothard died 1940.






In October 2016 I decided to create a small photographic project, spending time photographing the pool and it's surroundings.

I paid a number of visits to the area and I decided I wanted to convey the range of colours, textures and abstractions that appear and reflect on the surface of the pool.


I did this using a range of photographic techniques including Intentional camera movement (ICM), double exposure and out of focus shots.






































































About the author
